Industry leaders and decision-makers within companies requiring services and equipment for aquariums.

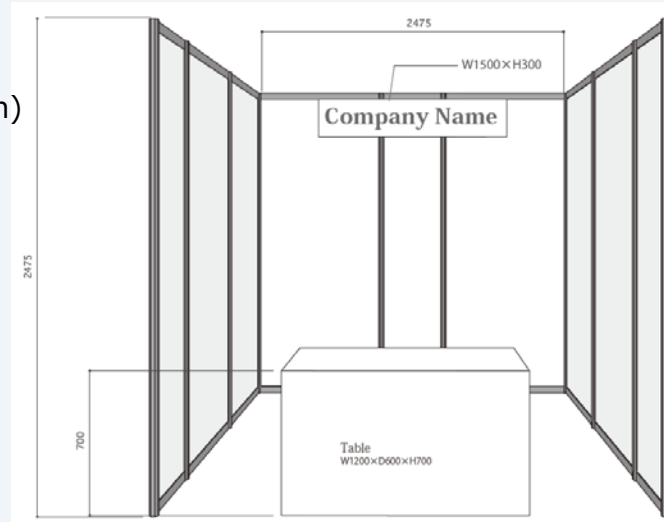
Shell Scheme

* For the basic work for an exhibit using multiple booths, we will separately make adjustments with respective exhibitor applicants.

All exhibitors are required to register the name of representative.

Only the representative will be given the congress badge which is required to enter the congress venue.

Cancellation/Reduction Policy

Cancellation or changes to your original booking must be submitted in writing to the Exhibition Secretariat of IAC 2018 Fukushima.

For cancellation made:

- **After issuing the invoice:**
30% of the total cost of each item will be retained
- **From May 1, 2018 to June 30, 2018:**
50 % of the total cost of each item will be retained
- **From July 1, 2018:**
100 % of the total cost of each item will be retained
